Technology Firm to Triple Employment in Zionsville

ZIONSVILLE, Ind. (Jan. 28, 2010) - Lt. Governor Becky Skillman joined executives from wireless management provider, Bluefish Wireless Management Inc., to announce the company will expand its operations here, creating up to 150 new jobs by 2013.

The Zionsville-headquartered firm, which oversees wireless device management services for many Fortune 100 companies, will invest \$2.7 million to grow its existing space at the Northwest Technology Park from 20,000 square-feet to 60,000 square-feet.

"Indiana continues to see impressive job creation from our many entrepreneurial IT firms," said Skillman. "Companies like Bluefish Wireless develop technologies that allow companies around the world to be more successful and I am proud that their game-changing innovations were born here in the Hoosier State."

The nine-year-old company provides services including procurement, custom kitting, billing and customer service for more than 500,000 wireless devices. The firm currently employs more than 70 associates and will begin hiring additional customer service and IT workers in the first quarter of the year.

"We are thrilled to be able to announce our expansion in our hometown," said Joshua Garrett, director of Bluefish. "We sincerely appreciate the assistance of Boone County and the state of Indiana. The incentives offered will allow us to hire needed employees more quickly as well as invest in the equipment that is necessary in order to stay on the cutting edge of technology. The quality of employees we're able to find in central Indiana is what makes our company successful. Our customers constantly mention the 'Hoosier Hospitality' they experience when interacting with our employee base, we're excited to add to that base with this announcement."

In 2009, Bluefish Wireless Management was selected by the Indiana Economic Development Corporation and its Small Business Development Center network as one of the 50 Indiana Companies to Watch.
